# CyberHome to bundle all navigation devices with HDX4

**CyberHome literally makes the mobile market move with its innovative ideas. All navigation devices like the NMD 35 (coming soon) will, in addition to finding the fastest way to your destination, be able to play music and video files while you're driving. To get most of these innovative hardware features, CyberHome decided to bundle its hardware with the video compression software around the HDX4 codec.**

CyberHome Europe AG joins the mobile market with a new brand called "CyberDrive". The handy CyberDrive gadgets' motto is a firm "I know the way" and they combine up-to-date GPS navigation with state-of-the-art multimedia capabilities. Devices like the NMD 35 are small enough to fit into your pocket and let you find your way from here to there, wherever you are. In addition to all that, you can listen to your favourite music, watch photos and play your favourite videos on the excellent, large coated display that also acts as a touch-screen. With the support of SD and MMC cards there is no more trouble with too little space to keep everything on one device.

### **In Combination with the HDX4 Movie Creator**

CyberHome is with immediate effect bundling its GPS navigation systems NMD 35, NMD 35 TMC and the upcoming NMD 43 with an OEM version of the HDX4 Movie Creator. The HDX4 Movie Creator is capable of reading a magnitude of different video formats and resolutions and creating tightly compressed high-quality MPEG-4 videos from any source. The resulting files take up only a fraction of the space the original material required, opening up a whole new range of potential target devices which were out of scope with traditional encoding schemes, first of all mobile devices with limited memory and processor power.

Klaus Hahn from CyberHome Europe AG: "Movies compressed by HDX4 can be stored in MPEG-4 on small memory cards without a problem. With one of our CyberDrive devices, immediate playback is nothing to worry about, wherever you are."

### **Great feature: Non-linear adaptive stretching**

The upcoming CyberDrive NMD 43 incorporates a modern display in 16:9 widescreen aspect ratio. In line with this display, the HDX4 Movie Creator already has a new feature called "non-linear adaptive stretching" that allows to adjust a video to whatever display size and aspect ratio a device has, without distorting the video, adding black borders or cutting off parts of the picture.

To achieve this goal, the border parts of the video are automatically stretched or compressed, in an unobtrusive way that generates much less irritation than the traditional methods. No more eggheads, no more black borders due to non-matching aspect ratios,

even for 4:3 TV productions on 16:9 displays. (2291 characters, released free of charges for print)
